Rooms and Suites:	 41 Standard rooms offer 34 sqm of space and all enjoy panoramic mountain views, private terrace and double or two single beds. All 39 Superior Rooms are at least 34 sqm and enjoy a private terrace with pool view. Each is stylishly appointed in soft earth tones and features either a double bed or two twins. The 68 Deluxe Rooms have a private terrace with striking views over the Red Sea and 34 sqm of space. There are 67 Standard family rooms each offering a total of 42 sqm. A master bedroom with double bed is divided with a sliding door from a second room featuring two singles. A terrace overlooks the mountains. 35 Superior Family Rooms offer two interconnecting bedrooms with a generous 42 sqm of space and a pool view. A sliding door divides a master bedroom space from a room with two single beds. 43 Deluxe Family Rooms provide dazzling views of the Red Sea, two adjoining rooms with a double bed in one and two twins in the other. The total room space is also 42 sqm. 9 Senior Suites offer an extra level of comfort with a private terrace with sea view and with 57 sqm of space, plenty of room to unwind in style. All rooms enjoy a separate living room and free mini-bar. Two adults can be accommodated and an extra bed is available at a charge. 2 Tala Bay Suites provide the epitome of resort style. With 122 sqm of space, a private terrace with pool view, the suites are ideal for guests looking for an extra level of luxurious comfort.

Sightseeing:	 Photogenic Wadi Rum has been the setting for numerous films including Indiana Jones. With soaring mountains, vast plains and ancient Bedouin history, this is a unique Jordanian experience. The ancient Jordanian city of Petra has captured the imagination of travellers for centuries, cut from the cliff face in the heart of the mountains it is a Unesco World Heritage Site and one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Dana Nature Reserve is an incredible eco-system featuring more than 600 species of plant, around 180 different varieties of bird and more than 40 different mammal species including gazelles, foxes and wolves. Additionally there are almost 100 archaeological sites based in the reserve.
